Completion and Obstacles

The majority of respondents expected to complete their degree in two years (48%) and 43% succeeded in completing in that amount of time. A significant number of students expected to earn their degree in 3 years (33%), and 29% succeeded in completing in three years.

Work, financial commitments, and family obligations were considered the main obstacles to students in achieving their degrees.

Half of the respondents indicated they accumulated up to \$25,000 in graduate school debt. In addition, another 29% reported more than \$25,000 in graduate education debt.
