Common Application: The standard application form distributed by the National Association of Independent School Principals for a large number of private colleges who are members of the Common Application Group.

***Community service program:** Referral center for students wishing to participate in volunteer activities.

Cooperator: A student category includes students

Clock hour: A unit of measure that equals one hour.

Continuous basis (for program enrollment): Enrollment at an institution on a continuous basis from the time of enrollment and beginning of the program.

Cooperative education: A program of study in which the student alternates periods of attendance at an institution with periods of employment in industry, or government.

Cooperative housing: Cooperative housing in which the student and participate in housing.

***Counseling services:** Personal counseling services.

Credit: Recognition of achievement by the recipient toward the

Grade-point average (academic high school GPA): The sum of grade points a student has earned divided by the number of courses taken. The most common scale is 4.0, with four points for an A, three points for a B, two points for a C, one point for a D, and zero points for an F. Weighting gives students additional points for more difficult courses.

Graduate student: A student who holds a bachelor's degree and is currently enrolled in a graduate program.
